Common Name: Coast Horned Lizard Scientific Name: (Phrynosoma coronatum)

- Species of special concern
- $2\frac{1}{2}$ 4 inches
- Highly dorso-ventrally flattened
- Horns on back and sides of head
- Two rows of fringe scales along each side of body
- Requires loose, sandy soils and leaf litter to bury
- Found in coastal sage scrub, sparse to moderately dense chaparral, clearings in riparian woodland and grassland
