Common Name: Pacific Treefrog
Scientific Name: (*Pseudacris regilla*)

- Color varies greatly from brown to green and spots to generally solid coloration
- Eye stripe
- Pointed snout
- Breeds November to July in slow streams, ponds, vernal pools and reservoirs
- Found in grassland, chaparral, woodland, forest, and farmland near water
